is a GIVE-&-RECEIVE camp offering Middle School youth a weekend to explore a variety of local outreach ministries by morning, and have fun in the afternoons.

Our goal is for Christ to open the eyes of Middle Schoolers to the ways you can make a difference in your own community here and now.

Camp Schedule:

Camp begins Thursday night at Highland UMC at 6:30pm with Registration, Parent Info Session, and Opening Worship and Games.

Friday through Sunday parents drop off at 8:30am for worship and small groups. At 9 or 9:30am, groups head to their daily outreach ministry. You pack a lunch to eat in the van ride to your afternoon fun activity.

Parents pick-up Friday & Saturday at 3:30pm back at the church.

On Sunday night of camp, we have an **overnight lock-in** at the church full of pizza, games, and Manhunt.

On Monday, we take a day trip to **Wet 'N Wild Waterpark** in Greensboro. Parents pick up at the church at **5:30pm on Monday.**

Who can come?

ANY youth who have completed 5th through 8th grade. We encourage and welcome friends!

What's It Cost?

The total cost for the week is \$125 with a \$25 deposit due June 15, 2017. There may be a need for a small amount of spending money during the week.

How can Adults help?

Camp happens because of volunteers! Volunteer for one or more days as a group leader, for morning registration, or to provide food for the lock-in.

Do I have to stay for the lock-in?

Not everyone is ready for an over-nighter. We will go to bed at midnight. If you are still not comfortable staying all night, let us know in advance what time you want your parents to pick you up.
